I therefore agree that:

- 1. I will support the spiritual aspect of life at Salesian College by adhering to standards expected. Including attending masses and ensuring I'm respectful and mindful of the Catholic Ethos of the College.
- 2. I will ensure I arrive on time for tutor/assembly (as appropriate) every morning and accept sanctions where I fall below these expectations.

- 8. I will adhere to the expectations and ensure I too am working in silence when in directed silent study areas, such as the silent LRC.
- 9. I will support the College in matters of Health and Safety, Daily Procedures and Classroom Expectations in line with policies.
