It was wonderful seeing so many familiar faces at the Year 10 Parents Evening yesterday, our first inperson Parents Evening in three years. The atmosphere was extremely positive and my sense was the timing system (largely) worked well. Thank you for completing the parent survey. We had 666 respondents and I am working my way through reading all of your comments. Once I have done so I will get back to you in a fortnight's time with reflections on how we are working on your suggestions to improve the experience for your children. We were overwhelmed by the hundreds of positive comments, many of which I shared with staff today. One comment simply said we were a school 'Full of heart, love, patience, understanding and courage'. Thank you for each and every one, they will provide a needed lift heading into the final few weeks of term.

The survey is anonymous so if you raised an individual concern about your child please contact us and we will look into the matter. I contain below some of the headline figures from your 666 responses below:
