

Dear Parents / Guardians,

I hope this email finds you well. I am writing regarding updates for the Bronze Duke of Edinburgh scheme at Salesian.

Firstly, the next afterschool training session has been postponed and <u>there will be no</u> <u>afterschool training for the next two weeks.</u>

Therefore cohort 1's last training session will be on the 5th March and cohort 2's will be on the 12th March.

For the first aid session will be on **the <u>20th Feb</u> for Cohort 1 and the <u>27th Feb</u> for Cohort 2,** this will be a <u>5pm finish</u>. Children should change into PE kit afterschool, as they will need to lay on the floor and be put in the recovery position etc... It is a statutory requirement that participants must have attended first aid training before they go on expedition. If they cannot attend that week, they must attend the other cohort's training.

Leaders will be meeting with their groups to discuss how to submit and what counts as an assessor report (90% of the reason participants fail DofE). Please can you ask your child to keep their eyes open for an email from their leader about when their meeting will be.
