South Western Railway industrial action

ASLEF have now confirmed that strike action will be taking place on Tuesday 30th January 2024. An extremely limited service will operate on a small number of lines and the rest of the SWR network will be closed. This will again include the closure of the Weybridge – Chertsey loop. More information is available <u>on the strike page</u> of their website. The school will run minibuses from Weybridge on Tuesday morning. We have three available and they will make a return journey if necessary. Please note however, that due to sports fixtures and co-curricular events we do not have any minibuses to return students to Weybridge after school so arrangements will need to be made. Students are welcome to stay in the LRC after school should you need to pick them up later than 3.10pm.

On Monday 29th January and from Wednesday 31st January through to Tuesday 6th February there will also be action short of a strike (an overtime ban) affecting the network. We have been informed that services across the network will be subject to short notice alterations and cancellations are also possible although the hope is currently that rail customers should notice little change on these days.

School will run as normal next week and the expectation, as always, is that students will attend. Please do contact attendance@salesian.surrey.sch.uk should there be any issues.

I continue to be in contact with key political figures regarding the impact the poor service to Chertsey Station (not just on strike days) is having on school attendance and the education of our children. Monica Harding has been fighting this cause on our behalf and Ben Spencer MP has twice met Huw Merriman, Rail Minister to raise the issue, directly referencing Salesian School. I will continue to apply this pressure and will update you when I receive one.
