## <u>Revision Timetable</u>

This timetable has been put together in order to make sure you get some time with your teachers prior to each exam and you make the most of your final few weeks in College. Please have it with you every day and use it to see where you need to be and when.

**Before Half Term (Week One and Week Two):** These weeks you are expected to be in College full-time as usual, following the timetable in this booklet each day.

## Key Points:

## Exam Instructions

Please read through all of these instructions carefully. Remember these regulations and guidelines are here to support you to do your best and be prepared. Please ask if you are worried about anything at all.

## 1. <u>Timetable</u>

- Please check your timetable carefully to ensure that you can find all the written examinations you are expecting to be taking and the timings/venues of each exam. If there are any problems with your entries or timetable, please speak to Miss Fidge, Mr Odeneal or Mrs Bolton immediately.
- Morning exams start at 9am and afternoon exams start at 13.30pm, you are to line up 15 minutes before these start times.
- GCE examinations will be held at Highfield Road. Exam room allocations are shown on your personal timetable. Please check very carefully the venue and times for each of your examinations.

## 2. <u>Attendance</u>

- If you are late for an exam you must report to Mrs Picardo/Student Services.
- If you are unable to attend due to illness you must inform the College before the start time of your exam. Special consideration can only be requested with a medical certificate from your Doctor. Exams cannot be sat on another day.

#### 3. <u>Equipment</u>

- Please remember to take **all** equipment you will need into the exam, in a **transparent** pencil case. Bring rulers, protractors and compasses for all exams where you have to draw diagrams. You are responsible for providing **all** the equipment you require (including calculators batteries should be checked beforehand) so please check that you have everything you need, well before the examination period starts.
- You must only write in black ink/ball point pen or HB pencil as instructed on the front of the exam paper. Coloured pencils/pens may only be used for diagrams, maps etc. Highlighters can be used for highlighting questions only. Do **not** use to answer questions.
- Tippex or correcting fluid must not be used anywhere in your papers.
- Calculators, with lids removed, may be used unless you are specifically told not to. All previously stored data should be cleared. Please see JCQ calculator regulations notice for full details.
- You may take water in a clear plastic water bottle **with the label removed** into exam room. No fizzy drinks are allowed.

#### 4. Examination Regulations

- Please read the JCQ 'Information for Candidates' sheet which has been emailed to you and informs you of the Awarding Bodies regulations.
- Enter all examination rooms in silence.
- You must not talk or communicate in any way with other candidates during the examination.
- If you need any assistance during the exam, put up your hand so that an invigilator can see it and wait quietly.
- At the end of the exam when told to stop writing, you must do so **immediately**, as failure to do so could result in a report being made to the exam board and a penalty incurred.
- You may only leave the exam venue at the end of the examination, after being instructed to do so. Please do so quietly, as there may be other exams still in progress.

## 5. <u>Devices</u>

- Web enabled devices such as mobile phones/iPods/mp3/4 players and watches (of any kind) are not permitted in an exam.
- If a phone rings during an exam, or any of the above are found on your person inside the exam room, it has to be reported to the exam boards as a security breach and maybe regarded as misconduct. This could result in disqualification from all your exams.
- If it is absolutely essential that you have a mobile phone or any other electronic device in school on the day of your exam, you should make sure it is **switched off** and handed to an invigilator when entering the exam room.

(NB The school cannot be held responsible for the safety of mobile phones or other valuables during exam time)

#### 6. <u>Results</u>

- GCE Exam results will be available from the Highfield Road site on Thursday 15th August between **10.00am-12.00pm**.
- If you cannot attend and wish your results to be posted, please give a stamped addressed envelope to Student Services at Highfield Rd before Wednesday 17th July.
- You are only allowed to collect your own results, unless a letter authorising collection by other student/parent/sibling is handed to Student Services at Highfield Rd before 17th July. If a parent/guardian is collecting on your behalf, then proof of ID will be required on results day.

## 7. <u>Certificates</u>

Will be available for collection at the Celebration of Awards evening in the Autumn Term.
