Parent Survey

Thank you to everyone who completed the Parent/Guardian/Carer survey over the last two weeks; we had 568 responses in total. There were lots of positives to celebrate in the survey with the staff, our ethos, our results and our communication all being identified as strengths. In answer to the question 'what one thing could the school do to improve?' broad themes covered revision preparation for the students, further clarity over 'expected progress' and the setting and marking of homework. On the point of homework 75% of responders felt their child receives about the right amount of homework, with 15% suggesting there was too little and 10% too much. As the survey can be broken down into 'Student Year Groups' we are looking closely at how this is reflected in different year groups and we will respond accordingly.

The headline data from the survey is contained below. The survey tool we use compares our data to 'similar schools' nationally. Where comparative data is available this is contained.

Unauthorised Term-Time Leave (a Surrey CC notice)

A brief reminder that if children are taken out of school, without authority, for 5 or more days (which do not have to be consecutive), parents/guardians/carers will be liable to receive a penalty notice.
