HOW WILL YOU STUDY?

You will spend 80% of your time in the classroom and 20% on a work placement to equip you with the knowledge and skills companies are looking for.

INDUSTRY PLACEMENTS

Every T Level will include an industry placement with an employer focused on developing the practical and technical skills required for the occupation. These will last a minimum of 315 hours (approximately 45 days) but may last longer.

GRADING AND CERTIFICATION

Students who complete their T Level will receive an overall grade of pass, merit, distinction or distinction*. They will get a nationally recognised qualification which will show their overall grade alongside a breakdown of what they have achieved.

SKILLS AND TOPICS COVERED

- ↑ The business environment, customer interaction, end user and business needs;
- ↑ Ethical and moral issues regarding reliance upon technology;
- ↑ Search, storage, integration and organisation of data, and how organisations use and analyse various types of data;
- ↑ Understanding digital analysis and algorithms;
- ↑ Digital environments including physical, virtual and cloud systems;
- ↑ Relevant legislation such as international law in Cyberspace and data protection;
- ↑ Digital planning;
- ↑ Security issues including privacy, confidentiality and the sharing of information;
- ↑ Testing of software, hardware, data and tools.
